**Applying for a Job:** This helps students explore career opportunities, develop a CV and cover letter, and build the skills needed for employment. **Suitable for all year groups.**



**Checkers:** It introduces students to the classic game of strategy, helping develop critical thinking, planning, and decision-making skills in a fun and engaging environment. **Suitable for all ages.**

**Chess: Master Strategy & Mindset** Unlock critical thinking through Chess! Suitable for all skill levels, this elective covers the rules, tactics and strategies of the game, including famous grandmaster matches. Develop concentration, problem-solving and patience in a friendly, competitive environment. Learn to plan ahead, evaluate risks and make smart decisions both on and off the board. **Suitable for all years.**

**The Brilliant Club** This elective helps students build confidence in their academic skills through university-style learning. Students will visit a university, take part in challenging discussions, improve their research and writing skills, and work with expert university tutors. It is a great opportunity for students who enjoy learning and want to prepare for future education. **Suitable for Years 9 and 10s only.**

**Crochet** introduces students to basic crochet stitches and patterns while creating simple projects. A fun way to develop a new skill and make handmade gifts. **Suitable for all years.**

**Big Questions:** Explore life's biggest mysteries through philosophy, discussion, and debate. Question ideas like existence, morality, and the unknown while developing critical thinking, confidence, and communication skills. Discover different viewpoints and see how close we can get to finding answers! **Suitable for Years 7-11.**

**Beyond The Filter:** Discover how images are created, transformed, and brought to life! Learn creative editing techniques, experiment with effects, and turn your ideas into eye-catching digital designs. Perfect for anyone who enjoys photography, creativity, and making something unique. **Suitable for all ages.**

**Case Closed: Criminal Investigations** Become a crime scene investigator and learn how detectives use evidence, fingerprints, and forensic science to solve crimes. Work as part of a team to bring mysteries to a close. **Suitable for year 10s and 11s.**

**Japanese :** You will be introduced to the Japanese language. We will explore the writing system and familiarise ourselves with some key aspects of Japanese culture. You are also welcome to bring your own cultural references and share them with the group. **Suitable for Years 9 and 10s only.**

**Exploring law careers:** involves discovering different legal paths, from solicitors and barristers to roles in corporate law, criminal justice, human rights, and more. **Suitable for year 12s. Pentecost term only.**

**Drama Unplugged** uses games, improvisation, and creative challenges to build confidence, teamwork, and imagination. No experience needed. **Suitable for all years**

**Compose Like A Pro:** Explore how music is created across different styles, from film and games to pop and classical music etc. Learn simple composing ideas, experiment with sounds, and create your own mini pieces to share. **Suitable for Years 7-9.**

**Cross Stitch** helps students develop creativity, patience, and fine motor skills while learning basic stitching techniques and creating fun, decorative designs. **Suitable for all years.**

**Dream and Design** Dream and Design empowers students to turn ideas into reality through creativity and innovation. Students explore design thinking, sketching, prototyping, and project creation. **Suitable for all years.**



**Exploring Science Fiction** Step into the future and explore worlds shaped by imagination, technology, and big ideas. Discover dystopias, AI, space, and futuristic societies through stories, films, and creative projects. Perfect for curious minds who love adventure and asking “what if?” **Suitable for all years**

**Hums Model Making:** Bring history to life by designing and building models of castles, landmarks, and historical sites. This creative elective develops teamwork, research, and practical skills while exploring the past in a fun, hands-on way. **Suitable for all years.**

**Introduction to Law:** Explore the world of law through real-life cases, debates, and mock trials. Discover how the justice system works while developing confidence, critical thinking, and the skills to argue your case.

**Suitable for Years 10, 11, 12 and 13.**

**Media Studies:** Explore how media influences the world around us through clips, discussions, and creative activities. Learn how to analyse media, develop ideas, and create your own written responses while exploring topics such as film, advertising, news, and social media. **Suitable for Years 9, 10 and 11.**

**Mindful Origami:** Turn a simple sheet of paper into something amazing! Learn the fun art of Japanese paper folding while developing creativity, focus, and problem-solving skills. No experience needed — just bring your curiosity and see what you can create. **Suitable for all years.**

**Mehndi Art:** Explore the beautiful art of Mehndi and create your own intricate designs inspired by different cultures and traditions. Learn basic techniques, patterns, and creativity through hands-on practice. An allergy test will take place during the first session before any designs are created. **Suitable for all years.**



**Sit And Knit:** Learn the basics of knitting in a relaxing and creative environment. Develop new skills, follow simple patterns, and create something to keep, share, or donate. Whether you're a complete beginner or ready for a new challenge, come along and discover the joy of making something by hand! **Suitable for all years.**

### **Experimental Psychology Research**

Interested in Psychology and doing your own research? This course introduces key ideas in cognitive psychology and lets you design and take part in experiments.

You'll need to be open-minded, willing to learn new terminology, step outside your comfort zone, and work with others.

**Suitable for Years 10–11 and 12**

**Robotics:** Discover the exciting world of robotics by designing, building, and programming your own robots. This hands-on elective develops problem-solving, creativity, teamwork, and coding skills as students tackle a range of challenges and bring their ideas to life. No previous experience is needed—just curiosity and a willingness to experiment and learn. **Suitable for all years.**



**Science Adventures. Beyond What We Know:** A fascinating elective exploring the mysteries of the universe. From dark matter to black holes, and from the origins of life to unexplained phenomena, students investigate real scientific questions that are still unsolved. A fun, thought-provoking course for curious minds who love discovery and debate. **Suitable for Sixth Formers only.**

### KS3 and KS4 STEM Elective Pitch

Love solving problems, building things, and discovering how the world works? In this STEM elective, you'll explore science, technology, engineering, and maths through fun, hands-on challenges. From experiments to design projects, you'll think like a real innovator and work as a team to create solutions. Curious minds wanted—come and explore, create, and invent! Key Stage 3 (Years 7, 8 and 9) students will be in a separate group from Years 10 and 11.

### Vanguard Scholars

Advent 1 & 2 and Pentecost 1 & 2 only. Vanguard Scholars is an elective which promotes thinking about maths in different ways. We consider how data is used, how it is presented and collected. We will do experiments, discuss maths in the real world and see how the world is connected through numbers. **Suitable for years 12 and 13**

### Year 11 Academic

**Mentoring:** What is the elective? This is a programme designed to support Year 11 students in their core subjects; Maths, English and Science. Year 12 students will be given training to work one to one with a designated mentee. This will then ensure tailored and supportive revision for each student that participates in an environment where they can be honest about their worries/challenges in that particular subject. **Suitable for years 11 and 12 only. Advent and Easter Terms only.**

**Pod Squad:** A fun and exciting club where children create their own podcasts, share ideas, and tell stories. It helps build confidence, communication, teamwork, and digital media skills while encouraging creativity and self-expression. **Suitable for all ages.**



**Photography:** A creative and joyful activity where children learn how to capture great pictures. It helps develop observation, creativity, confidence, and digital skills while encouraging them to explore the world around them. **Suitable for all ages.**

**Culture Day Lent 1 & 2:** Auditions for Culture Day will be held before the Christmas break. ### **Conversational Gaelic – The Irish**

**Forum:** introductory lessons to learning conversational Irish (Gaeilge). The aim will be to focus on conversational fluency (key daily vocabulary) over accuracy with some embedded elements of the history of the Irish Language. **Suitable for all years.**

**Debate Club:** A wide range of topics will be debated based on current cultural topics. This will increase student cultural capital and awareness of the world around them. There will also be an opportunity to use leadership skills, develop confidence in oracy and to work as part of a team. **Suitable for Years 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13.**

**French Club:** The French Club is a fun and interactive elective for secondary students who want to improve their French skills.

Through games, songs, films, and cultural activities, students build vocabulary and confidence in speaking.. **Suitable for all years.**

**Current Affairs Elective:** Stay ahead of the headlines and explore the events shaping our world! You'll develop critical thinking, communication and media literacy skills while learning to form informed opinions on the topics that matter most. **Suitable for all years.**

**Game On:** This is a brain-training games elective. Explore the world of games beyond the screen you know! Discover online and strategy games from technology while developing problem-solving and critical thinking skills. Challenge yourself, compete with others, and discover new ways to play. **Suitable for years 7 and 8.**

**Hand Sewing Club:** Join our Hand Sewing Club and explore the creativity, culture, and community behind the art of making. Create fun projects like keyrings, bookmarks, patches, and more while learning simple stitches and new skills. No experience needed — come along, get creative, and stitch something you can be proud of! **Suitable for all years.**



**Elementary Polish:** Learn the basics of Polish through greetings, introductions, everyday phrases, and simple conversations. This elective focuses on building confidence in speaking, with extra challenges for students who already know some Polish. **Suitable for Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11.**

**Indian Cooking:** Discover the flavours of Indian cooking while learning how to prepare simple, tasty dishes safely and confidently. This elective helps develop cooking skills, teamwork, creativity, and knowledge of different cultures through fun hands-on activities. **Suitable for all years.**

**Eco Warriors Elective:**

Become a champion for the planet while taking on exciting environmental challenges! Through projects, teamwork, and creative problem-solving, you'll build leadership, collaboration, sustainability, and critical thinking skills as you explore ways to make a positive difference in your school and community.

**Makaton:** Students will learn how to communicate with people who find it hard to communicate using speech. Learning Makaton will give the students a wider understand and show them there are different ways to communicate by using their voice alongside hand gestures and signs. This will also show students that they have a voice no matter their ability/disability. This is a passion of ours supporting in SEND department we want the students to experience this opportunity. **Suitable for years 7s, 8s, and 9s.**

**MasterChef:** Learn basic cooking skills with a real chef in this hands-on elective. Students prepare beginner-friendly dishes while building confidence, kitchen safety, teamwork, and creativity through fun, practical culinary experience. **Suitable for all years. 10 places only.**



**Liturgical Choir:** Love singing? Join our Liturgical Choir and perform uplifting music throughout the year linked to the Church seasons. Build your confidence, teamwork, and vocal skills while using your talents to help lead worship and make a positive contribution to our school community. **Suitable for Years 7, 8 and 9.**

**The Lyric Lab:** This elective gives students the opportunity to study, be inspired and rewrite 'the greats'. In this elective, we dismantle iconic songs and poems to build something entirely new. Students will "hijack" classic verses—altering perspectives and considering the points of views of the writers—to find their own unique contemporary voice. Through listening to original concepts, they will transform existing works into original responses. From page to performance, they will come and learn how to challenge the narrative and position their own ideas. **Suitable for years 9, 10 and 11.**

Improve your technique, game awareness, and decision-making while taking part in fun challenges and competitive activities.
