

# UNIFORM POLICY

## RATIONALE

The governors of Cardinal Newman Catholic School support the wearing of a school uniform in order to help fulfill the aims of the school, in particular those listed below:

- ❖ *To be a Catholic community recognised by our love of God and of our neighbour*
- ❖ *To value and respect ourselves and all others.*

We believe wearing a uniform has many advantages:

- Promotes equality of opportunity for all students, social cohesion amongst pupils, and protection from social pressure to dress in a particular way.
- It helps give the pupils of the school a sense of identity, belonging, and positive self-image.
- Gives the school a well-respected profile and supports its Catholic, Christian ethos.
- Creates a culture of high expectations and high achievement within the school.

## PROVISIONS

1. All students, except sixth formers, are required to wear a full school uniform.
2. The uniform is designed to be acceptable to students, parents and staff and to be suitable (in terms of safety and comfort) for the range of activities pupils enjoy at school. Uniform is not about fashion and the expectation is that students will not add fashion items to their uniform or wear alternative 'more fashionable' versions of school uniform.
3. New students are given a Prestige uniform list, from which badged uniform can be ordered online, before they arrive. Items of uniform are also available in person from Prestige Design & Workwear Ltd, Unit 2, Barton Industrial Estate, Faldo Road, Barton Le Clay, Beds, MK45 4RP. (Tel 01582 883222)
4. The uniform list is published on the school website, in the student planner, and in information sent out to new parents. Reminders about the uniform details are sent out to all students at least once a year. Items are priced competitively, and the overall cost of the school uniform is kept as low as possible.
5. Occasionally, changes are made in consultation with the students, parents, and staff.
6. Through our family and pastoral support workers all students and parents have access to good quality nearly new uniform items at considerably reduced prices or when necessary, with no charge.
7. Requests to vary the uniform to meet the needs of individual pupils, e.g. for medical or religious reasons, will be carefully considered. However, in adopting this policy the governors have taken all possible steps to ensure that it is fair and reasonable, is non-discriminatory and acceptable to the majority. It would not be practical or productive to vary the rules except in the most compelling circumstances.
8. On a non-uniform day, it is expected that students will wear appropriate clothing for school (see Appendix A)
9. There are only three required branded items on our school uniform (Jumper, Tie, PE Shirt)

## MONITORING

1. All staff are involved in monitoring the standard of school uniform. If a pupil is not adhering to the uniform policy, their tutor will log the uniform infringement on classcharts each time and a detention is set for the next day (if student has a note, they do not receive a detention the next day).
2. Every child not meeting uniform expectations is taken to our pastoral support workers each morning to either rectify their uniform using our stock of nearly new uniform or remain out of circulation until a parent/carer brings the correct items into school.

3. The tutor or pastoral support worker rings home EVERY time a pupil arrives in school without following the school uniform policy and has **NO** note.
4. Tutors and then the Heads of Year have the responsibility to check uniform frequently. Pupils failing to meet our school expectations on uniform are discussed at weekly Year Team meetings to ensure that as a pastoral team to ensure consistency where every member of staff applies the uniform policy to all students equally it ensures all staff are upholding our school expectations. Phone calls home are monitored via classcharts and staff use this communication with parents to discuss individual pupils needs so that any additional support the student or the family needs is be actioned. Any concerns around student welfare is logged onto CPOMs.
5. If a tutor or pastoral worker needs to ring home about the same issue twice then a parental/carer meeting will take place as this may be an indicator of another issue that requires support. A Microsoft form will be sent out to all teachers of the student to ensure the tutor has up to date information about the student in advance of the meeting. If there is not an improvement, a second parental/carer meeting with tutor and the Head of Year (family support worker and/or pastoral support worker may be invited to this meeting).
6. If a student continues to refuse to remove an item of jewellery or not wear our school uniform which they have at home after being out of circulation and following a parental meeting, then a suspension will follow and the reintegration meeting with parents is held with the assistant or deputy headteacher.
7. The Uniform is non-negotiable, and parents are expected to support the school by ensuring their children are wearing the correct uniform in the correct way (e.g. shirts tucked in, skirts not rolled up, trousers not worn below waist). The head teacher can discipline a student for not wearing the school uniform and a student can be given a suspension or even a permanent exclusion if they repeatedly ignore the uniform rules. As the school holiday's start, I want to take this opportunity to re-establish what the term school shoes means at Cardinal Newman School. This letter is to avoid money being spent on shoes labelled in shops as "school shoes" that will in fact be unacceptable here at Cardinal Newman. This is not an exhaustive list.

School trousers is another item that can cause confusion only full length black straight or bootleg trousers are allowed please remember just because they are in the school uniform section of a shop **does not** make them acceptable here at Cardinal Newman. We identify trousers that do not follow this rule when they are tight on the ankle (trousers labelled skinny fit or are fit and flare can cause issues) or have visible zips or piping down the center examples of trousers not acceptable are shown below:



Trousers must not cling (wrinkle) at any part of the leg to the ankle, they must be loose on the ankle.
