

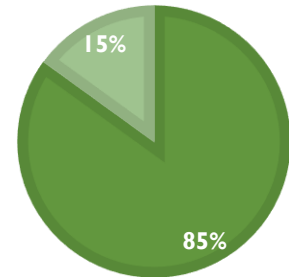
## Summary of Points Awarded January – March 2023

### Achievement vs Behaviour points

- 85% of all points given are achievement and 15% of all points are given are behaviour points.
- Over 66% of all achievement points awarded are for effort/positive contribution in class.

This is a tremendous ratio and reflects the superb engagement of all the students in their learning and lessons.

### Since January

#### *Lunchtime Detentions*

- 93% have had less than 5 lunchtime detentions for 2 behaviour points
- 81% have had less than 2 lunchtime detentions for 2 behaviour points
- 70% have never had a detention

#### *Head of year Detentions*

- 97% of students have had 2 or less HOY Detentions
- 92% of our students have had 1 or less HOY detention
- 88% of students have not had a HOY detention

- The number of Lunchtime detentions is significantly decreasing since the beginning of the year.
- During the first half term (September – October) there were 617 detentions across the school which reduced by over 120 for January – March.
- Significantly fewer disruptions to learning
- It is a very small minority of students that are receiving detentions in the school that we are working with to reduce this even further.

### Uniform

- September - October 309 students in incorrect uniform. 124 students in incorrect uniform more than once.
- January - March 205 students in incorrect uniform. 78 students more than once.

Students are responding extremely well to the high standards that we have at CNS.
