Social Media

Social media is a part of life and can be used in many positive ways. However, dealing with disagreements and activity on social media is taking up more and more of the time of the pastoral team at CNS. I would like to encourage you to discuss with your child their use of social media as well as regularly check their phones to ensure that they are using the different platforms responsibly.

<u>Vaping</u>

There is a growing trend, nationally, that considers vaping to be acceptable for teenagers. In fact, it is illegal for anyone under the age of 18 to purchase vaping products therefore, vapes are entirely banned at Cardinal Newman School. Vaping has many negative side effects. These include that they are highly addictive, impact hormone levels and development, impact levels of concentration and can be mixed with more harmful chemicals including some illegal substances such as cannabis. Please discuss these issues with your children and highlight the negative impacts that these e-cigarettes have on their bodies and minds. Vapes are becoming more and more prevalent and we need your support to ensure they don't become a problem in school.

Our philosophy at CNS is that no child should go hungry during the day so we have always allowed a small amount of debt whilst parents top up their accounts.
