Thank you for the extremely positive feedback regarding Classcharts and the difference it is making in you being aware of what is going on as well as being able to support the school with decisions that we make. For your information we have standardised the way we award achievement points and streamlined how behaviour points are awarded. Our aim is always to have five more achievement points than behaviour points, currently we have ten achievement points for every one behaviour point! This is tremendous.
