Please do pray for all those making decisions around this that a swift decision can be made to draw this disruption to a close.

Yesterday we had nearly 300 very excited Year 6 students in school for the day getting used to the idea of becoming CNS students in September. It was a wonderful day rounded off by meeting all the parents in the evening as well. We are very much looking forward to welcoming them all as members of this community. Year 10 had a wonderful opportunity on Wednesday to have workshops with Dr Van De Spoel who supports our students with study habits, memory and confidence for exams.
