Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your continued patience whilst we manage the situation with our blocks and the contractors working to the schedules that they have now been set. Below is the position from Monday 22nd January.

Week beginning 22nd January

Onsite

- Year 9
- Year 11
- Year 12 (the whole year group will now attend)
- Year 13

Offsite

- Year 7 at home – live lessons
- Year 8 at home all week – live lessons
- Year 10 at home all week – live lessons

Work on the four classrooms in food and science has now been completed which means the whole of Year 12 can now attend from Monday. We are hoping that we can start to get Year 7 in later in the week, as and, when rooms become available in the main block. We will give you ample warning if this is the case. There is a clear programme in place that means that the main block will be able to populated floor by floor over the coming 2.5 weeks. In order to get year groups in we need to make sure that all the safety checks have been carried out, cleaning has happened and that the rooms, corridors and facilities are all accessible and useable.

The whole school's desire is to get all students in as quickly as possible. However, as expressed previously, this is all dependent on the contractors completing the mitigating works and the environment being safe for all staff and students. The Department for Education continue to be impressed by the speed at which we have been able to action the mitigating works and the speed of progress, this has not been the case nationally over the last months with building issues in other schools. My thanks go to all those involved in this from the school, trust, diocese and DfE.
