Students will study one foreign language for 4 hours every 2 weeks.

Adjectives and the rule of the agreement – Near future tense (French only)

Past tense with personal pronoun “I” – Reflexive verbs – Comparatives and superlatives

Modal verbs - Compound nouns (German only) – Accusative case (German only)
